

PPRC 2026 RULES AND CLASSIFICATIONS

Shooter Classifications:

- PPRC Tier 1
- PPRC Tier 2

How Shooters are Classified:

- PPRC Tier 1:
 - Tier 1 shooters will consist of any shooter that has performed at a consistently high level in the past PPRC Series. If you have finished in the top 12 in previous years of the PPRC series you will be classed in Tier 1.
 - Tier 1 shooters will consist of any shooter that has finished a year ranked in the top 15 of a regional PRS series.
 - Tier 1 shooters will also consist of any shooter invited to the 2025 PRS Pro-Series finale regardless of their attendance.
- PPRC Tier 2:
 - Tier 2 shooters will consist of any shooter that is new to PRS and this would be considered their first year shooting PRS matches.
 - Tier 2 shooters will consist of anyone that does not meet any of the Tier 1 criteria.
- First time members or new shooters to the series will be classified in Tier 2. These shooters could be upclassified to Tier 1 based on performances in other competitive shooting sports.

Tiers / Gear:

- There will be no individual divisions recognized for end of season payouts. Shooters will be able to participate with a rifle from any division within each classification.
- All matches will still count for PRS points in their respective divisions. Shooters will also earn their respective trophies for each division and category they participate in. All shooters must adhere to PRS rulesets to ensure points can count.
- Standard PRS rules for caliber and speed will remain in effect. 3200fps max velocity and 300win mag max caliber.

Participation Requirements:

- A minimum of 3 matches is required, with a maximum of 14 matches to compete in.
- Top 3 Match Scores will make up your point total.
- The Finale Score will be added as a 4th and final score to determine placement and payout for the season.
- Points can only be earned by shooting matches at MKM Precision or the Geissele Range.
- There is no requirement to shoot both ranges.
- Membership must be purchased prior to a match for that match to count for points.

Payouts:

- Tier 1 Payouts: Top 5 shooters
- Tier 2 Payouts: Top 8 Shooters
- Payouts based on the percentage of participation for each classification.
- Governing Board Members will not be eligible to win any prize money from the series.
- Payout schedule will be released by October 1, 2026.
- All winners will be required to complete a W9 prior to receiving their winnings.
